Is a gateway into God's presence (Psalm 100:4)	• Is where we bow, submit, and yield (John 4:23)
Can be done by anyone	Requires relationship & surrender
External expression	Internal posture

Key Understanding: Praise celebrates God's works — worship surrenders to God's worth.
